



## **Labour Market situation**


**Overall unemployment rate** – 9,2 % (165 980).

## **Requirements for EU/EEE citizens**

EU member state citizens and their family members intending to work in Lithuania under an employment contract do not need to obtain a work permit. They can participate in recruitment procedures and find jobs under the same conditions as Lithuanian citizens.



# Moving to Lithuania

#### 1. A valid passport or National ID card

2. If you plan to stay for more than **90 days**, you are required to **register your residence** at the Migration Department.

3. Once you've registered, you will receive a **Personal Identification Number (PIN), which is necessary for various administrative tasks like opening a bank account or renting an apartment.** 

4. **European Health Insurance Card** (EHIC). But if you stay longer, it's good to register with Lithunia's healthcare system.

5. If you have an **EU driving license**, you can use it in Lithuania without any issues.





# **Requirements for Non-EU**

Non-EU citizens typically require a work permit to be employed in Lithuania. Ensure your employer sponsors your permit application and complies with all legal requirements.



### **Cover letter**





Lithuania has a strong education system, with free public schools and universities. Higher education institutions are internationally recognized, offering a variety of programs.




#### Healthcare System
